SUMMARY: The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has published a notice of proposed rulemaking (NOPR) that proposes to revise its test procedure for residential furnaces and boilers established under the Energy Policy and Conservation Act. DOE published this NOPR so stakeholders can review the proposed revisions. After receiving a request for additional time to comment, DOE has decided to extend the comment period for the NOPR pertaining to the test procedure for residential furnaces and boilers until July 10,

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

DOE published a NOPR in the Federal Register to make available and invite public comments on its proposed revisions to the test procedure for residential furnaces and boilers. 80 FR 12876 (Mar. 11, 2015). The document set a deadline for the submission of written comments by May 26, 2015. The Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) requested an extension of the public comment period,

stating that additional time is necessary to conduct product testing and review supporting information in order to prepare and submit comments. DOE has determined that extending the comment period to allow additional time for interested parties to submit comments is appropriate based on the foregoing reasons. DOE believes that extending the comment period by 45 days will provide the public with sufficient time to submit comments responding to DOE's proposed test procedure revisions. Accordingly, DOE will consider any comments postmarked by July 10, 2015, and deems any comments received by that date to be timely submitted.
