## **Consent Order - Where We Are**

- 2005 Compliance Order on Consent Remains in Effect
- ☐ The 2012 Framework Agreement Remains in Effect
- ☐ On May 30, 2014 NMED was notified that the 3706 Campaign deadline under the Framework Agreement would not be met
- □ There are 15 documents subject to stipulated penalties under the consent order for FY15
  - Based on schedule, project durations and funding limitations, LANL will be unable to meet many of the stipulated penalty documents on time
  - Requested meeting with NMED to discuss





## **FY15 Annual Work Plan**

- Based upon full-year FY15 funding uncertainty and increased liability, unable to finalize FY15 Integrated Priority List with NMED
  - Continuing Resolution for 1st Quarter of FY15
    - CR at FY14 funding level of \$225M (Oct 1, 2014 Dec 11, 2014)
  - FY15 Senate Mark \$225M
  - FY15 House Mark \$180M
- Minimum FY15 Scope Includes:
  - TRU minimum operations and nitrate salt processing
  - LANL chemistry in support of radiological release at WIPP
  - Groundwater protection and remediation (quarterly monitoring, sampling, maintenance, and reporting)
  - Surface water protection monitoring and strategic planning
  - IP corrective action campaign (EPA Permit)
- □ Additional scope will be based on final FY15 funding and NMED and DOE priorities
