On September 29, 2016, AHRI staff and walk-in cooler and freezer (WICF) manufacturer representatives met with representatives from the Department of Energy (DOE) to discuss the test procedure Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) published on August 17, 2016. Attendees discussed issues related to the rating of WICF systems utilizing hot gas. The current federal test procedure does not include a method to calculate an AWEF for products with hot gas defrost. Lastly, attendees discussed the proposed requirements to display the net capacity.
