NOTICE OF ALLOWANCE TO RESUME DISTRIBUTION

Manufacturers of certain covered products which have been determined by the Department of Energy (DOE) to be non-compliant with the applicable energy conservation standard may be allowed to resume distribution, per 10 CFR § 430.70 (a)(6)(v), if additional testing demonstrates compliance. On June 16, 2010, DOE issued a Notice of Non-Compliance Determination based on test results submitted by Westinghouse Lighting Corporation showing that certain models were noncompliant. The models are manufactured by Fuzhou and privately labeled by Westinghouse. Fuzhou later admitted that the original test results were based on testing that was not performed in accordance with DOE regulations. Fuzhou has now conducted the testing required by DOE regulations and has submitted complete test data, which DOE has reviewed closely.


FINDINGS

Based on the new test data, DOE has now determined that product code 0521000 complies with applicable DOE energy efficiency standards. As of October 8, 2010, Fuzhou may resume distribution of this product.

This represents the last of 12 product codes identified in the June 16, 2010 Notice of Non-Compliance Determination. DOE issued a Notice of Allowance to Resume Distribution of the other 11 models on August 10, 2010.
