
UPDATED CLEAN ENERGY FINANCING GUIDE RELEASED IN CONJUNCTION WITH CLEAN ENERGY MINISTERIAL

At the beginning of June, Secretary Moniz hosted the 7th Clean Energy Ministerial in San Francisco. It was the first gathering of global energy leaders since last December's climate negotiations in Paris and focused on expanding international collaboration in clean energy research, development, demonstration and deployment to combat climate change, drive economic growth, and help ensure energy security.

As part of this effort, LPO contributed to the Department's <u>release of the third edition of its Federal Financing Programs for Clean Energy</u> guide, which provides an overview of clean energy financing programs available through ten agencies from across the government.
