**SUBJECT**: DOE O 458.1 Admin Chg 1, Radiation Protection of the Public and the

Environment

**SUMMARY**: The Department has made administrative changes to the above listed Directive on February 11, 2011. The order establishes DOE requirements to protect the public and the environment against undue risk from radiation associated with radiological activities conducted under the control of the DOE pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. This Order supersedes DOE O 458.1 and cancels DOE O 5400.5 Chg 2, except for Chapter III, Derived Concentration Guidelines, and Figure IV-I, Surface Contamination Guidelines.

Under the Department's Directives Program (DOE Order 251.1C), Heads of Field Elements are generally responsible for determining which contracts are to include the CRD. Contracting Officers, once notified, are responsible for incorporating the CRD into affected contracts. Since some Heads of Field Elements may not be aware that this change has been issued, Contracting Officers should request their determination of which, if any, contracts are affected and remind them that they may sign up for automated notification at <a href="https://www.directives.doe.gov">www.directives.doe.gov</a>.
