Rational for determination:

Blaine County School District #61 proposes to install a series of Ground Source Heat Pumps which will service Carey High School, Bellevue Elementary School, Woodside Elementary School, and Wood River Elementary School. However this project is in the process of conducting their feasibility study and has yet to select neither a Ground Source Heat Pump system nor the exact project locations for installation. Therefore DOE will issue a determination for Phase 1 "Feasibility Study and Engineering Design" of the project. Phase 2 "Installation and Commissioning of Equipment" will require further NEPA review immediately following site selection and conceptual system design. DOE will require all information collected during Phase 1 to be submitted to the Department for further NEPA review before project implementation can occur.

This information gathering presents no environmental impact and therefore this task is Categorically Excluded under CX A9 "Information Gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice" from further NEPA review.

The testing of water temperature and chemistry to be conducted during Phase 1 will utilize existing wells in the area therefore will have no significant impact to human health and/or environment and is therefore Categorically Excluded under B3.1c "Environmental Monitoring".
