Description:

- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Activity #3 Benchmarking, Education, and Outreach

Activity #4 Quality Inspection, Measurement, and Building Codes

Activity #5 Traffic Signal Synchronization

Activity #6 Expansion of County Recycling Program

Activity #8 Renewable Energy Technologies

The following activities fall outside the bounds of the signed SOW but qualify for a categorical exclusion under NEPA:

Activity #2 Incentive Funds, (sub-activities building retrofits, plumbing or site retrofits aimed toward energy efficiency gained through water conservation [RSC Rebate Program], building commissioning, re-commissioning, or retrocommissioning [Facility Benchmarking]), are categorically excluded under CX B5.1

Activity #7 Greenhouse Gas Reduction Program consists of a feasibility study to evaluate methane capture capacity at two county landfills, regulatory support for GHG reporting, data collection at the county's Waste to Energy (WTE) facility and analysis of WTE operations to determine further opportunities for emission reductions and is categorically excluded under CX A9.

The following activities were already categorically excluded under NEPA, but were included on the signed SOW:

Activity #1 Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy

Any projects submitted for EECBG funding that fall outside the bounds of the signed SOW, other than the Activity #2 sub-activities listed above, will require a separate NEPA determination review.
