Proposed Action or Project Description

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Conduct residential and commercial building audits (Complete) (CX approved on 9/1/2009), and 2) conduct energy efficiency retrofits as identified in building audits that will result in the highest energy efficiency gains which includes the following activities: replacing chiller, decreasing number of night lights in building, adding sweep on/off lighting controls, upgrading primary and secondary pump controls, resetting boiler set point, installing night setback of perimeter heating system, updating controls/operating strategies for Atrium Unit, installing direct combustion air intakes for boilers, installing occupancy sensors for private offices, and replacing exterior parking lot lights

Conditions: None
