Description:

B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

This NEPA determination is for Budget Period 2 (BP2) activities.

DOE is proposing to provide Federal funding to the recipient to support the design, construction and demonstration of a skid mounted thermo-chemical process comprised of Intergrated Rapid Pyrolysis system (RTP) and Bio-oil upgrading to transportation fuels pilot Bio-refinery at the Tesoro, Kapolei site.

The skid facility will be less than 1 acre within a 10 acre site at the Tesoro refinery. The site once held a bioremediation facility that was demolished in 1998. Debris was removed and the site has been vacant since. UOP's pilot-scale biorefinery will be immediately adjacent to an active tank farm.

All construction will be within or contiguous to an existing facility where roads and utilities are readily accessible. All utilities will be provided by Tesoro. CX B3.6 applies to this project.
