Description:

- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

## Rational for determination:

The State of Arizona will provide \$962,914 in Recovery Act funds to Motor Excellence to equip and staff an 11,600 square foot manufacturing facility for the production of high efficiency e-bike motors. Motor Excellence is located at 1409 E. Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ.

The company's facility is located off a secondary highway in a commercial/industrial zoned area within the city limits. Recovery Act funds will be used to remodel the existing facility, hire several key manufacturing experts, acquire needed manufacturing equipment, retain a consultant to assist in identifying lean manufacturing "best practices" for the new facility, and allow the purchase of an Enterprise Resource Planning software program. The remodeled building will provide administration offices and a conference room in the front; electrical, mechanical, and manufacturing engineering offices in the middle; and e-bike manufacturing lines, quality control, and inventory in the back. The company has obtained a building permit from the City of Flagstaff for the work proposed. All construction/renovation will occur inside the existing building; the work will not impact the footprint of the facility. The project does not reside in a historic district nor will it disturb a building of historic significance. The recipient has provided documentation of the waste stream management plan that will be in place during construction and operation of the facility.

In view of the information provided by the State and recipient, DOE has determined that the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion B1.15, B1.31 and B5.1.
