Rational for determination:

Clark County, WA proposes to use \$500,000 of EECBG funds for the following activites which are bounded by the signed SOW and are therefore categorically excluded. These projects are being reviewed as part of a project modification where a previously reviewed project has been eliminated, and will be replaced by Activities 8 and 9.

Activity #8 - WSU Building Upgrades: according to the Grants Manager, this project will include lighting retrofits and installation of heat pumps at the 78th Street Public Works Operations Center.

Activity #9 - Energy Manager Matching Funds: this activity will provide funds to the cities of Camas and Washougal for participation in a Resource Conservation Manager program with the City of Vancouver. This activity will not involve construction.
