Title: Upgrade Communication/Control Systems to BC Brine Disposal Well (GFE & Install)

Description: Subcontractor shall provide remote operations control equipment as Government

Furnished Equipment (GFE) associated with BC-MM-575A to upgrade control systems at

the BC brine disposal wells.

Subcontractor shall provide all labor, tools, materials, equipment (except GFE), and supervision to perform the work associated with BC-MM-575 to upgrade control systems at the BC brine disposal wells. The de-energizing/re-energizing of the Remote Operation Controller and software configuration/programming will be performed by the M&O Contractor. Subcontractor shall recover the material and equipment being dismantled, removed and/or demolished that has been identified as Government Salvage and deliver

to the Government's onsite representative.

Regulatory Requirements: NEPA Implementing Procedures (10 CFR 1021)

- Disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and /natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or
- 4. Adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources.

Categorical Exclusion to be applied: B1.7

Acquisition, installation, operation, and removal of communication systems, data processing equipment, and similar electronic equipment.
