Description:

- A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

Lower providence township of Pennsylvania proposes to use federal funding to install an educational-use solar array outside of the Municipal Complex and perform a feasibility study on the installation of a solar array at the Moyer landfill. The installed solar array at the municipal complex will be a demonstration at 28kW and will aid in the promotion of solar power throughout the community.

The 28kW solar array will consist of 120 modules located in the rear of the municipal complex. The current land-use of this area is mowed grasses and has at one time been graded to level for the construction of the municipal complex. There are no listed structures within the area that are on the National Register of Historic Places. An educational curriculum will also be created to incorporate the solar power knowledge in to the local school districts educational programs.

This award will also use monies to perform feasibility study of the Moyer landfill to determine regulatory requirements, economic needs, and technical engineering for the installation of solar panels on the closed and capped landfill.

This project is comprised of feasibility studies, solar panel installation of education program development; therefore a CX A9 & B5.1 will apply.
