Description:

B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

Rational for determination:

This NEPA review is a continuation of NEPA review GFO-09-057n. In this project the Vermont Sustainable Jobs Fund will further their research initiatives in Carbon Harvest Energy to research the suitability of landfill gas combustion products for commercial algae cultivation. This project is focused on the development of algae that are receptive to the landfill gas carbon dioxide.

This project will include the development and fabrication of a photobioreactor (lab scale), lab support and condensate collection systems development, testing and analysis of gas samples with algae, and project management and reporting.

The applicant has submitted an R & D Questionnaire which thoroughly addresses the chemical and safety handling protocols associated with this project. All work will be performed at the University of Vermont in the Rubenstein Ecosystem Science Laboratory.

This project is comprised of research and development activities within a laboratory; therefore this project qualifies as CX B3.6 under DOE NEPA review.
