Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

Rational for determination:

Pleasant Grove City, Utah proposes to use federal funds to create a renewable energy source from community waters. Specifically, the City proposes to design, test, install, develop and document a micro hydro-electric system. The proposed site is near the mouth of the Battle Creek Canyon where the city's water supply is stored. Public outreach and education activities are also proposed.

This project would include 5 phases: Project development outreach and education, design and bid, construction, evaluation and testing, and reporting. This NEPA review only applies to Tasks 1.0 through 2.3, excluding subtask 2.2.1 Equipment Procurement, which comprise information gathering, project planning, environmental permitting, and preliminary design. Additional NEPA review is required prior to initiating final design, equipment procurement, site preparation, and installation.

Tasks 1.0 through 2.3, excluding 2.2.1 Equipment Procurement, entail information gathering, preliminary design, and planning, therefore a CX A9 applies.

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.
