Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to Great Basin College (GBC) to expand an existing geothermal heat pump system on campus in Elko, Nevada. The project would be completed in two phases with multiple tasks in each phase. Phase I would include planning and permitting to expand the existing ground source heat pump system for the campus. Phase II would include system expansion. This NEPA determination applies to all of Phase I and Phase II Tasks 7 and 8 only.
