Proposed Action Title: Line 3002 and 3002A Electrical Transmission Line Reconductoring Project

Program or Field Office: Southwestern Power Administration

Location(s) (City/County/State): Butler, and Stoddard Counties, Missouri

<u>Proposed Action Description</u>: Southwestern Power Administration proposes replace utility poles and transmission line conductor along portions of an existing transmission line to accommodate increased electrical loading and prevent electrical outages due to overloading of the electrical grid system within the geographic region.

<u>Categorical Exclusion(s) Applied</u>: 10 CFR 1021, Appendix B to Subpart D, Part B2.5– Safety and environmental improvements of a facility that do not result in a significant change in the expected useful life, design capacity, or function of the facility and during which operations may be suspended and then resumed.

To fit within the classes of actions listed in 10 CFR Part 1021, Subpart D, Appendix B, a proposal must be one that would not: (1) threaten a violation of applicable statutory, regulatory, or permit requirements for environment, safety, and health, or similar requirements of DOE or Executive Orders; (2) require siting and construction or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities (including incinerators), but the proposal may include categorically excluded waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment actions or facilities; (3) disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that there would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; (4) have the potential to cause significant impacts on environmentally sensitive resources, including, but not limited to, those listed in paragraph B(4) of 10 CFR Part 1021, Subpart D, Appendix B; (5) involve genetically engineered organisms, synthetic biology, governmentally designated noxious weeds, or invasive species, unless the proposed activity would be contained or confined in a manner designed and operated to prevent unauthorized release into the environment and conducted in accordance with applicable requirements, such as those listed in paragraph B(5) of 10 CFR Part 1021, Subpart D, Appendix B.
