Replacement Pilot. Tasks include the subcontractor providing all wireless radios to be tested and installation of the wireless network at the Bayou Choctaw SPR site. Testing of the wireless radios and wireless network will be performed by FFPO personnel during the

pilot test.

- Disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and /natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or
- 4. Adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources.

Acquisition, installation, operation, and removal of communication systems, data processing equipment, and similar electronic equipment.
