Description:

B3.6 Small-scale research and development. and pilot projects

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of facilities for smallscale research and development projects; conventional laboratory operations (such as preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than 2 years) laboratory operations, frequently conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions, provided that construction or modification would be within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Not included in this category are demonstration actions, meaning actions that are undertaken at a scale to show whether a technology would be viable on a larger scale and suitable for commercial deployment.

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rationale for determination:

PPG Industries, Inc. is proposing to use DOE funding to design a fabricate-on-demand manufacturing process to overcome the cost and supply chain inefficiencies preventing widespread adoption of Vacuum Insulating Glazing units

Project activities would involve research, modeling, developing, fabricating and testing prototype window units that use improved edge-sealing, pillar placement and gas evacuation processes. PPG industries, Inc. would partner with Oak Ridge National Laboratory to accomplish project objectives. Work would take place in existing laboratory facilities at each location. All handling and process operations would occur in-lab in accordance with proper handling and processing protocols. Existing Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) policies, procedures, and training are sufficient to safely conduct the proposed work. No toxic or hazardous materials are anticipated for use in the project; however, both facilities have a well-established program for disposing of generated hazardous or toxic waste. The amount of materials anticipated for use is well within the current permitted and planned waste handling limits at each facility. No facilities modifications or construction are expected. Existing facilities would be used as intended. No new permits would be required to conduct the project.

For all work conducted at DOE laboratories, project activities may be subject to additional NEPA review by the cognizant NEPA Compliance Officer for the lab and will be required to meet the labs health and safety requirements.

DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions covered under DOE CX A9 (information gathering) and B3.6 (small-scale research & development projects; conventional laboratory operations) and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
