# TRAINING

Objective:

TR1 - The training and qualification for operations, maintenance, and operations support personnel, have been established, documented, and implemented. (CR3)

# Criterion:

The training and qualification records for operators, radiation technicians (RT), maintenance personnel, and supervisors conducting or supporting drum treatment activities in the DTF, identify training and qualification requirements, document that required training has been completed and required qualifications are current, and certification of operators has been completed.

# Objective:

TR2 Level of knowledge of managers, operations, and operations support personnel is adequate based on reviews examinations and examination results and selected interviews. (CR4)

- a. Examinations adequately cover training material.
- b. The nuclear facility manager (NFM), shift managers, shift team leads (STL), radiation shift team lead (RSTL), operators, RTs, and maintenance personnel conducting or supporting drum treatment activities in WMF-628 have passed required examinations.
- c. Managers, operations and operations support personnel conducting or supporting drum treatment activities in the DTF have demonstrated their level of knowledge in interviews and during mockup operations.

#### Objective:

TI13 Installation of the DTF, its support systems, and drum treatment activities in the DTF have been reviewed for potential impacts on training and qualification. Training has been performed to incorporate all aspects of these changes. (CR5)

#### Criteria:

- a. The training needs assessment was adequate to identify required classroom or on the job (OJT) training.
- b. Appropriate training was provided to address training requirements.
- c. Personnel conducting or supporting drum treatment activities in the DTF have completed all training requirements.
