## **MANAGEMENT (MG)**

### Objective:

- a. Procedures, organization charts and or position descriptions have been updated to include roles, responsibilities, and reporting relationships for drum treatment activities in the DTF.
- b. Personnel supporting or conducting drum treatment activities in the DTF understand their roles and responsibilities.

# Objective

**MG.2** Sufficient numbers of qualified personnel are available to conduct and support drum treatment activities in the DTF. (CR6)

#### Criteria:

- a) AMWTP management has evaluated staffing levels and determined that sufficient qualified personnel are available.
- b) Mockup operations and drills demonstrate that sufficient personnel are assigned.

## Objective:

MG.3 An adequate startup plan has been developed that includes plans for graded operations and testing after startup. (CR12)

## Criterion:

a. The startup plan includes plans to confirm operability of equipment, the viability of procedures, and the performance and knowledge of operators, and additional oversight during initial hot operations.
