




ACT River Basin Water Control Manuals

ACT APPROACH

- Produce WCM w/project appendices (8 manuals) and supporting NEPA (1 EIS)
- 6 year, \$8.5M effort
 - > \$1.76M FY13 Budget (\$760K obligated, \$680K expended)
 - ▶ \$320K FY14 Budget
- Reflect current operations and system capabilities
 - Changes in hydrology, physical plant, operational practices
 - Navigation and Drought plans
 - > NEPA
 - > Existing water storage contract amounts

ACF River Basin Water Control Manuals

ACF APPROACH

- Produce master and project WCM's(6 manuals), Water Supply Storage Assessment (WSSA) and supporting NEPA (EIS)
- 4 year, \$4.7M effort
 - ➤ \$900K FY13 Budget (Carryover)
 - ➤ \$600K FY14 Budget
 - ➤ \$1.7M FY 15 Budget
 - ➤ \$500K FY 16 Budget estimate
- To reflect water management operations, water supply storage and system capabilities
 - Changes in hydrology, operational practices and water supply storage
 - Navigation, Flood Risk Management and Drought plans
 - > NEPA
 - Draft water storage contract amounts, if appropriate
