Seeking Authority to Import Natural Gas from Canada to the United States and Application of Irving Oil Commercial GP (with Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. acting as its agent in the U.S.) Seeking Authority to Export Natural Gas from the United States to Canada, Case No. 15-111-NG

Dear Mr. Nussdorf:

As we have discussed, Irving Oil Commercial GP of Saint John, New Brunswick, Canada applied for a long-term license authorizing the export of approximately 26 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from the United States to Canada. Its sister entity, Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. of Portsmouth, New Hampshire, acted as its U.S. agent, pursuant to the "Notice of Procedure," adopted earlier this year. See 80 Fed. Reg. 11664 (March 4, 2015). In addition, Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. (a U.S. entity) applied for a long-term license authorizing the import of approximately 9.83 Bcf from Canada into the United States.

In the course of review, the Department of Energy has posed several questions, and this supplemental submission provides the requested information.

- Irving Oil Commercial GP is a general partnership that is established/registered in New Brunswick, Canada and has its principal place of business in Saint John, New Brunswick, Canada.
- 2. Irving Oil Limited is a corporation incorporated in New Brunswick, Canada and has its principal place of business in Saint John, New Brunswick, Canada.



- Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. is a corporation incorporated in the State of Delaware and has its principal place of business at 190 Commerce Way, Portsmouth, New Hampshire, 03801.
- 4. Pursuant to the "Notice of Procedure" adopted in March 2015, Irving Oil Terminals Operations Inc. (a U.S. entity) is acting as agent for service of process and related matters for its Canadian sister entity, Irving Oil Commercial GP, in the license application requesting authority to export approximately 26 Bcf of natural gas from the U.S. to Canada. Irving Oil Commercial GP is the principal entity seeking the authority. The partnership neither resides nor has a principal place of business or other corporate presence in the United States.

We hope this letter fully responds to the questions posed and clarifies Irving Oil Terminal Operations Inc.'s limited role in the license application to export natural gas to Canada.
