Dear Mr. Michaels:

In the email below, sent to you on September 14, 2021, we informed you that SCT&E's counsel had filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Counsel (Notice) pertaining to SCT&E's non-FTA application (Application) pending in Docket No. 14-98-LNG. We further noted that SCT&E has not submitted any documentation to progress the Application since March 2015. We stated that, if SCT&E wishes to proceed with the Application, it should submit the name of SCT&E's new legal counsel and any other relevant updates about the Application within 30 days (*i.e.*, by October 14, 2021), to comply with DOE's regulations.

As of today, DOE has not yet received a response. We have also left messages at the listed phone number but have not received a response. If SCT&E wishes to remedy SCT&E's deficient Application and continue to pursue this request, please let us know as soon as possible. If DOE does not receive a response by **November 22, 2021**, DOE will move forward with dismissing the Application, without prejudice to SCT&E filing a new non-FTA application in the future (10 CFR § 590.203).

Please be aware that, even if the Application is withdrawn, SCT&E's Order No. 3566 in Docket No. 14-89-LNG granting authorization to export LNG to FTA countries will remain in effect. We note that you timely filed a Semi-Annual Report on behalf of SCT&E in that docket on October 1, 2021.

On August 13, 2021, David Wochner notified our office that he and Sandra Safro of K&L Gates LLP no longer represent SCT&E LNG, LLC (SCT&E) in its proceeding with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) in <u>Docket No. 14-98-LNG</u>. In that docket, SCT&E filed an application (Application) on July 24, 2014, in which it requested authority to export domestically produced liquefied natural gas (LNG) from a proposed terminal to be constructed on Monkey Island in Cameron Parish, Louisiana, to non-free trade agreement (non-FTA) countries. Mr. Wochner listed you as the contact for SCT&E, and we note that you are also listed in the Application.

In reviewing the docket, we further note that SCT&E has not submitted any documentation to progress the Application since March 2015.

Under DOE's regulations, an applicant is required to maintain legal representation throughout the application process, to ensure that the requested export is within the applicant's corporate powers. See 10 CFR § 590.202(c). In addition, applicants are required to "amend or supplement the application whenever there are changes in material facts or conditions upon which the proposal is based." Id. § 590.204(a).

If SCT&E wishes to proceed with the Application, please submit the name of SCT&E's new legal counsel (or submit a notification if you are SCT&E's counsel) and any other relevant updates about the Application within 30 days of this email. If SCT&E wishes to withdraw the Application without prejudice to filing a new non-FTA application in the future, please let us know.
