Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC ("Sabine Pass") hereby submits1 for filing under seal, a nonredacted copy of a NAESB Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas ("Base Contract") and a Transaction Confirmation ("Confirmation"), entered into by Sabine Pass on April 15, 2014 and August 27, 2019 (respectively) with Ascent Resources - Utica, LLC ("Ascent"). Under the Base Contract and Confirmation, Ascent will sell and Sabine Pass will purchase natural gas on a long-term basis. The Confirmation amends and restates the terms of a Transaction Confirmation executed by Ascent and Sabine Pass on June 6, 2018, a nonredacted copy of such earlier Transaction Confirmation also being submitted herewith for filing under seal.1 Sabine Pass intends to liquefy the natural gas purchased from Ascent at the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal.
