Overview of MEAG Power

- Joint Action Agency
 - Formed in 1975
 - Owns and operates electric generation and transmission facilities
 - Provides bulk electric power to 48 cities and 1 county in the State of Georgia
- All 49 Participants have reaffirmed 50-year power sales extensions
- Take-or-pay contracts with participants are court validated contracts with a General Obligation pledge from each city
- Generation ownership interest in 10 generating units and a transmission system
 - 2,069 MW generating capacity online
 - 500 MW Plant Vogtle Units 3 & 4 under development
- Schedules the output from the SEPA contracts for the 49 members
 - 431 MW hydro capacity
