City of Indianapolis, Office of Sustainability

- WIDE
 - 800 small projects
 - Concentrated in an area with current revitalization underway
 - Partnership with area community development corporation
- DEEP
 - 400 larger projects
 - Work with established non-profit CDFI
 - City wide loan program
 - Partnerships with local utilities, retailer, contractors

- 800 homes in a concentrated 20 neighborhood area
- Comprehensive Energy Audit and delivery of
 - Air Sealing
 - ✓ Direct Install Measures faucet aerators, lo-flow shower heads, CFL bulbs, water heater / pipe wrap, and smartstrips
- Attic insulation when needed
- Audit and EcoHouse information drives customer to choose additional energy upgrades

Coordinated effort between programs to bring all resources to bear for the customer



Eligible Homeowners



- 1. Be willing and able to repay a loan
 - Stable and ongoing income
 - No more than 45% of income going for debt repayment
- 2. Have acceptable credit references
 - Credit Score 580-615 minimum
 - Acceptable non-reporting credit references, such as rent, utilities, etc. will be considered
- 3. Meet INHP income criteria, up to 120% of the Area Median, based on household #



Eligible Homes



- Are within the City of Indianapolis
- Are occupied by the owner of record for the past 12 months
- Are 1-2 units
