ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3134-A

On August 14, 2012, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Tenaska Gas Storage, LLC (Tenaska) in DOE/FE Order No. 3134. In that order, DOE/FE authorized Tenaska to export up to 1,600 billion cubic feet of natural gas to Canada for a two-year term beginning on August 14, 2012, and extending through August 13, 2014.

On December 12, 2013, Tenaska notified DOE/FE that, due to inactivity, it no longer needs the blanket authorization. Tenaska therefore requests that DOE/FE retroactively vacate Order No. 3134, effective January 1, 2014. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to export natural gas to Canada granted to Tenaska in DOE/FE Order No. 3134 is hereby vacated, effective January 1, 2014.
