ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3378-A

On January 30, 2014, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Encana Natural Gas Inc. (Encana) in DOE/FE Order No. 3378 to import and export liquefied natural gas (LNG) from and to Canada and Mexico by truck, rail, barge, and non-barge waterborne vessels, in a volume equivalent to 12 billion cubic feet of natural gas over a two-year term beginning on February 15, 2014, and extending through February 14, 2016.

On November 19, 2014, Encana notified DOE/FE that it has ceased its LNG importing and exporting business and no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Encana therefore

requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3378, retroactively effective January 1, 2015. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to Encana in DOE/FE Order No. 3378 is hereby vacated, effective January 1, 2015.
