Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph I of DOE/FE Order No. 3290, Freeport-McMoRan Energy LLC (“FME”) hereby submits its semi-annual report describing the progress of the proposed liquefaction facility.¹ Development activities are continuing, and discussions are continuing with the Maritime Administration regarding an application for authorization to construct the Main Pass Energy Hub™ Deepwater Port. FME is exploring commercialization arrangements for the project. FME expects the first floating liquefaction storage and offloading vessel at the Main Pass Energy Hub™ Deepwater Port to begin exporting LNG during the 2020 timeframe.
