I hereby wish to register strong opposition to and grave concern about the Export Proposal:

- •Presently natural gas sells at 3 to 4 times as much on foreign markets than it does here in the US. This vast difference in price would drive up domestic prices.
- •Exportation of natural gas reduces the supply of natural gas available for domestic use, which in turn would weaken the US economy.
- •Of even graver concern is that Natural gas (methane) is a greenhouse gas that is 86 times more potent than CO2. Recent studies show that leaks of gas from drilling, transmission and distribution make it no better for the global environment than coal.

Hence, natural gas exports are not in the public interest

Furthermore, because this comment period was not widely and only very recently announced announced, affected parties have not been given sufficient time comment adequately or to intervene.

I therefore request an extension of time to comment and intervene in this proposal
