ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND
EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3489-A

On September 18, 2014, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy (DOE/FE) granted blanket authorization to Iberdrola Energy Services, LLC (Iberdrola) in DOE/FE Order No. 3489, authorizing Iberdrola to import and export natural gas to and from Mexico over a two-year term beginning on September 18, 2014, and extending through September 17, 2016.

Subsequently, on March 11, 2016, Enstor Energy Services, LLC (Enstor) notified DOE/FE that Iberdrola's corporate name was changed to Enstor on February 18, 2016. Enstor therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3489 as of the date of the name change. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas to and from Mexico granted to Iberdrola in DOE/FE Order No. 3489 is hereby vacated, effective February 18, 2016.
