Description:

- **A**9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).

## Rational for determination:

PPG Industries, Inc will be conducting a materials investigation and fabrication methodology for the enhancement of wind turbine fiberglass materials.

They will be conducting project work at their Science & Technology Center laboratories in Shelby, NC. An R&D questionnaire has been submitted for these locations that thorough addresses waste stream, liquid effluent, hazardous waste and personnel safety, all of which comply with OSHA standards and their NPDES permits.

This project comprised information gathering, dissemination and bench-scale research; therefore a CX A9 and B3.6 will apply.
