Proposed Action or Project Description

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Develop energy efficiency and conservation strategy (CX approved 10/14/2009), 2) conduct a residential and commercial buildings audit to address energy conservation and efficiency options specific to the Gakona Multi Purpose Community Services Center, 3) implement energy efficiency building retrofits as identified in the building audit to enhance the efficiency of the Gakona Multi Purpose Community Services Center (EXCLUDES BUILDING RETROFITS), 4) install energy efficient doors and windows in the Gakona Multi Purpose Community Services Center, and 5) investigate alternative energy technologies as recommended in the building energy audit to enhance efficiency of the Gakona Multi Purpose Community Services Center (EXCLUDES IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES)
