Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Every project under this determination is less than or equal to 11 tons. All projects listed are vertical, closed loop ground source heat pump systems. The exchange fluid for these projects is a mixture potable water and food-grade propylene glycol. The MN GSHP rebate program requires contractors to be licensed and/or bonded as applicable under state or local requirements. All electrical work must be performed by a licensed electrician working for a licensed electrical contractor. The ground-loop installers for these projects are IGSHPA-certified.

No wetlands or flood plains or coastal zones will be impacted by any of the projects on this list as these resources do not exist at the project sites. All project information has been submitted to the local SHPO in the State of MN in regards to state permitting. As part of the requirements within the program all SHPO consultation and permitting must be completed before construction activities can occur. Every project has submitted a waste management plan for all waste generated by the projects.

DOE is aware that four of the six projects listed above have been completed.

DOE has reviewed the information for the proposed projects and determined that these projects do not pose a significant impact to human health and/or environment. Therefore these projects are categorically excluded under B5.1 "Actions to Conserve Energy".
