Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the Midwest Renewable Energy Association (MREA) to develop a "train-the-trainer" program for solar technologies in a seven state region. DOE funds would be used to hire local coordinators to identify and manage local training networks.

DOE made a previous NEPA determination for Phase 1 (GFO-0005676-001; CX A9 and A11; signed 1.13.2012). This NEPA determination applies to Phase 2 only.

Phase 2 activities would include development of a collaborative process to train solar instructors. The training would involve co-teaching arrangements for new instructors to gain teaching experience, instructor training courses, resource development groups that bring instructors together to develop classroom resources and an instructor discussion group. Through this process, MREA would refine and expand this training program in partnership with other organizations throughout the Midwest.

Based on this information, DOE has determined the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in categorical exclusion A9 (information gathering) and A11 (technical advice and assistance to organization).
