The installation, modification, operation, and removal of commercially available solar photovoltaic systems located on a building or other structure (such as rooftop, parking lot or facility, and mounted to signage, lighting, gates, or fences), or if located on land, generally comprising less than 10 acres within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to the Kennebec Valley Community College to continue advancing the Solar Instructor Training Network (SITN).

DOE made a previous NEPA determination for Phase 1 (GF0-10-094; CX A9, A11 and B3.6; signed 12. 28.2009). which involved the construction of a solar heating and cooling training facility on campus. This NEPA determination applies to Phase 2 - 4.

Phase 2 – 4 would continue to facilitate the creation of a well-trained, solar energy workforce in the Northeast region (Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts and New York). The proposed project would continue to identify and train local photovoltaic (PV) installers. Trainers would receive stipends to attend training, develop instructional resources and participate in the Northeast Solar Training Provider - North meetings. DOE funds would also be used to purchase PV training equipment and a mobile PV training unit. No construction or new facilities would be built.

Based on this information, DOE has determined the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in A9 (Information gathering, analysis and dissemination), A11 (technical advice and assistance to organizations) and B5.16 (solar photovoltaic systems).
