Order No. 202-07-3

On December 20, 2005, the Secretary issued Department of Energy (DOE) Order No. 202-05-3. On January 19, 2006, David K. Paylor, Director of the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Environmental Quality, and the City of Alexandria, Virginia submitted requests for rehearing of Order No. 202-05-3 concerning the Mirant Potomac River Generating Station. Also on January 19, 2006, the District of Columbia Public Service Commission submitted a request for clarification or, in the alternative, rehearing of Order No. 202-05-3. The three rehearing requests were submitted pursuant to section 313 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. 8251. On February 17, 2006, in Order No. 202-06-1, rehearing of Order No. 202-05-3 was granted for the limited purpose of further consideration.

On January 31, 2007, Order No. 202-07-2 was issued. That order renewed and extended Order No. 202-05-3, and kept the rehearing requests open for the limited purpose of further consideration. By its terms, Order No. 202-07-2 expired on July 1, 2007. As a result, the requests for rehearing are now moot and accordingly are denied.

The order shall be effective upon its issuance.
