MANAGEMENT (MG)

Objective:

MG.1 Functions, assignments, responsibilities, and reporting relationships are clearly defined, understood and effectively implemented. (CR2)

Criteria:

- a. Procedures, organization charts and or position descriptions have been updated to include roles, responsibilities, and reporting relationships for drum treatment activities in the DTF.
- b. Personnel supporting or conducting drum treatment activities in the DTF understand their roles and responsibilities.

Objective

MG.2 Sufficient numbers of qualified personnel are available to conduct and support drum treatment activities in the DTF. (CR6)

Criteria:

- a) AMWTP management has evaluated staffing levels and determined that sufficient qualified personnel are available.
- b) Mockup operations and drills demonstrate that sufficient personnel are assigned.

Objective:

MG.3 An adequate startup plan has been developed that includes plans for graded operations and testing after startup. (CR12)

Criterion:

- a. The startup plan includes plans to confirm operability of equipment, the viability of procedures, and the performance and knowledge of operators, and additional oversight during initial hot operations.
