The Interdisciplinary Science Building (ISB) project team successfully delivered a modern research facility with the goal of enabling breakthroughs in energy research and development. The ISB project created 60 new laboratory modules in an interdisciplinary environment, a state-of-the-art Ultra-Low Vibration Laboratory suite and Brookhaven National Laboratory's first "dry-room" for battery research. Outstanding project management and comprehensive planning allowed the ISB project to exceed performance goals for vibration, energy efficiency, and technical scope by delivering 35% more research space than the minimum required and achieving a LEED Gold certification.
