ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3375-A

On December 19, 2013, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Devon Canada Marketing Corporation (Devon Canada) in DOE/FE Order No. 3375 to import up to 50 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on February 1, 2014, and extending through January 31, 2016.

On April 3, 2014, Devon Canada notified DOE/FE that its parent company, Devon Canada Corporation, recently divested its conventional assets and associated transport obligations, and therefore the current authorization is no longer needed. Devon Canada therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3375, retroactively effective April 1, 2014.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas from Canada granted to Devon Canada in DOE/FE Order No. 3375 is hereby vacated, effective April 1, 2014.
