Thanks to your support and participation, DVU has been a powerhouse in learning and development. Within the DVU hub there are myriad learning opportunities, training information for our diverse workforce, as well as course catalogues and tools for career development.

- *Did you know that DVU has college courses available 24/7?* We built the DVU Learning Channel, offering 627 courses from over 100 colleges as well as posting the Department's latest recorded webinars.
- *Did you know that DVU is where you can find training announcements?* We featured 106 announcements in the last 12 months.
