ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3133-A

On August 14, 2012, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Hess Corporation (Hess) in DOE/FE Order No. 3133 to import and export up to a combined total of 200 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on August 17, 2012, and extending through August 16, 2014.

On April 29, 2014, Hess notified DOE/FE that it does not anticipate undertaking any further import or export activity pursuant to the authorization. Hess therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3133, effective the date of this Order.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to Hess in DOE/FE Order No. 3133 is hereby vacated, effective May 15, 2014.
