ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 3280-A

On May 7, 2013, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Gavilon, LLC (Gavilon) in DOE/FE Order No. 3280 to import and export up to a combined total of 100 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on May 11, 2013, and extending through May 10, 2015.

On April 29, 2014, Gavilon notified DOE/FE that it has ceased its natural gas marketing business and no longer needs the current blanket authorization. Gavilon therefore requests that DOE/FE vacate Order No. 3280, effective April 29, 2014. DOE/FE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada granted to Gavilon in DOE/FE Order No. 3280 is hereby vacated, effective April 29, 2014.
