



***CALL FOR POWERPOINT/VIDEO PRESENTATIONS  
For the  
2015 National Environmental Justice Conference and Training  
Program's Youth/Emerging Leaders Summit***

As part of its Youth/Emerging Leaders Summit, the *2015 National Environmental Justice Conference and Training Program* (NEJC) planners are inviting individuals or groups, ages 15 to 25, to submit PowerPoint or Video presentations, not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes in length, related to environmental justice in their respective communities. Each PowerPoint or Video presentation should include the submitter's name(s), affiliation, and full contact information. Additional rules and requirements are attached.

The overall conference theme is *Enhancing Communities Through Capacity Building and Technical Assistance*. While the 2015 Conference will have a special focus on "*Climate Justice*," the conference planners are interested in presentations in all environmental justice related areas. At least three (3) of the submitted PowerPoint/Video presentations will be selected to be presented during the Youth/Emerging Leaders Summit on March 11, 2015 in Washington, D. C. Other submitted PowerPoint/Video presentations will be available for viewing throughout the 2015 National Environmental Justice Conference and Training Program. Those individuals/groups (no more than four (4) representatives per group) whose PowerPoint/Video presentations are selected to be presented during the Youth/Emerging Leaders Summit must register for the conference and will be provided/reimbursed conference travel expenses and hotel accommodations.
