



- serve as representatives of DOE/NNSA site contractors, DOE/NNSA Field Offices, and DOE/NNSA Headquarters Elements

# **PROCUREMENT EVALUATION AND RE-ENGINEERING TEAM CHARTER**

## **Purpose:**

The Procurement Evaluation and Re-engineering Team (PERT) will provide support to the Department of Energy (DOE) / National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Senior Procurement Executives (SPEs) and the Contractor Supply Chain Council (CSCC) in the following areas:

- procurement system reviews
- procurement process improvement
- knowledge management, training, performance measurement and management
- other related business management initiatives, studies, and projects identified by the SPEs, CSCC or PERT Chairpersons, as beneficial to the DOE/NNSA federal and/or contractor business community.

## **PERT Structure:**

The PERT membership will consist of representatives from all major DOE/NNSA site contractors, DOE/NNSA Field Offices, and DOE/NNSA Headquarters Elements. The PERT membership roster may be found at [www.hanford.gov/chmert](http://www.hanford.gov/chmert) and <https://max.omb.gov/maxportal/home.do>

The PERT shall be co-chaired, on a rotated basis, by:

- a representative appointed by the DOE Senior Procurement Executive
- a representative appointed by the NNSA Senior Procurement Executive
- a representative appointed by the DOE contractor representatives on the PERT
- a representative appointed by the NNSA contractor representatives on the PERT

Ad-Hoc Committees are created by the PERT Chairpersons to address issues which have contractor complex-wide interest or implication.

## **Responsibilities and Authorities:**

Senior Procurement Executives and the Contractor Supply Chain Council (PERT Sponsors)

- identify or request specific activities and expectations for the PERT
- evaluate the PERT results/conclusions
- provide recommendations on PERT actions
- provide guidance and feedback for actions initiated by the PERT

PERT Chairpersons

- plan and coordinate PERT activities and projects
- arrange and conduct all PERT meetings including agendas, logistics, and distribution of information and results
- coordinate with SPEs and CSCC to ensure appropriate prioritization and report on PERT activities and accomplishments
- designate subcommittees to address specific activities
