**Re: Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC  
FE Docket Nos. 10-85-LNG and 10-111-LNG**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

On September 7, 2010, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy (“DOE/FE”) issued an Order granting Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC’s (“Sabine Pass”) application under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (“NGA”) <sup>1</sup> for long-term, multi-contract authorization to export up to the equivalent of 803 billion cubic feet (“Bcf”) per year of liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) from the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal in Cameron Parish, Louisiana (“Sabine Pass LNG Terminal”) to nations with which the United States has entered, or in the future enters, into a free trade agreement (“FTA”) requiring the national treatment for trade in natural gas. <sup>2</sup> On August 7, 2012, DOE/FE issued a Final Opinion and Order granting Sabine Pass’s application under NGA Section 3 for long-term, multi-contract authorization to export up to the equivalent of 803 Bcf per year of LNG from the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal to nations with which the United States has not entered into an FTA requiring the national treatment for trade in natural gas. <sup>3</sup>

In both DOE/FE Order No. 2833 and DOE/FE Order No. 2961-A, DOE/FE directed Sabine Pass to file with DOE/FE’s Office of Natural Gas Regulatory Activities “all executed long-term contracts associated with the long-term supply of natural gas to the Sabine Pass LNG

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Terminal ... within 30 days of their execution.”<sup>4</sup> More recently, DOE/FE has stated that it “recognizes that some information in long-term contracts associated with the long-term supply of natural gas to the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal may be commercially sensitive.”<sup>5</sup> Thus, DOE/FE has given Sabine Pass the option to file long-term contracts under seal along with a public summary of the major provisions of the contracts.<sup>6</sup>

Sabine Pass entered into the enclosed North American Energy Standards Board (“NAESB”) Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas with Range Resources – Appalachia, LLC (“Range Resources”) on December 1, 2013.<sup>7</sup> Pursuant to the terms of the NAESB Base Contract, the enclosed Transaction Confirmation (“Confirmation”) documents a transaction whereby Range Resources agrees to sell to Sabine Pass a fixed quantity of natural gas on a firm, long-term basis. Sabine Pass intends to liquefy the natural gas secured under the Confirmation for export from the Sabine Pass liquefaction facility, pursuant to the authorizations granted in the above-referenced proceedings.

The NAESB Base Contract and Confirmation contain commercially sensitive information, and are being filed herewith under seal. A summary of the major provisions that are not deemed confidential is set forth below.

#### **I. Public Summary of Confirmation**

Pursuant to the Confirmation executed by Sabine Pass on June 17, 2014, Sabine Pass agreed to buy natural gas from Range Resources for a five-year term beginning on the first day of the month immediately succeeding the date on which all four of the following conditions have been met: (1) Sabine Pass has notified Range Resources that the date of commercial operations from the first LNG liquefaction train at the Sabine Pass liquefaction facility (Train 1) has occurred; (2) the commercial in-service date of Range Resources’s firm transportation contract on Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC’s (“CGT”) proposed Leach Xpress Project has occurred; (3) the commercial in-service date of Range Resources’s firm transportation contract on CGT’s proposed Rayne Xpress Project has occurred; and (4) the commercial in-service date of Sabine Pass’s firm transportation contract on Transcontinental Gas Pipeline Company, LLC’s (“Transco”) proposed Gulf Trace Project has occurred. The primary delivery point is at CGT’s Meter Station 478 mainline delivery point to Transco in Evangeline Parish, Louisiana. There are no take-or-pay or equivalent provisions/conditions or restrictions in the Confirmation.






