As required by DOE/FE Order No. 3555, issued on December 2, 2014, SeaOne Gulfport, LLC ("SeaOne") herby files its second semi-annual report.

Progress of the Facility: On June 1, 2015, SeaOne, the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, and the Mississippi Development Authority executed a Lease Option Agreement on a site at the Port of Gulfport where SeaOne intends to operate its Compressed Gas Liquid (CGL) facilities. SeaOne continues to hold discussions with the relevant regulatory authorities in the State of Mississippi to finalize plans for the permitting and construction of its production and shipment facility.

SeaOne commenced the project front end engineering and design (FEED) activities early in September, 2015 and expects these activities to be completed by the middle of 2015.

Anticipated Start Date of Operations: SeaOne anticipates starting commercial operation of its facilities in late 2018.

Status of Long Term Export or Supply Contracts: SeaOne is in the process of negotiating long-term contracts for the export of CGL, but has not yet concluded any such contracts.
