The U.S. Department of Energy invites you to Orlando, Florida, for the 2016 Annual Meeting of the National Transportation Stakeholders Forum (NTSF). The event will be held at the Rosen Plaza on June 7-9th and will be co-hosted by the Southern States Energy Board and the Tribal Caucus.

"Stewards of the Environment" is the theme for the Forum, which will focus on the Department's remediation efforts and national planning strategies for the safe transport of radioactive materials. As in the previous years, the 2016 NTSF will serve as a collaborative gathering point for representatives from federal agencies, state, local, and tribal governments, private industry and other entities associated with these important issues. During the meeting, participants will receive timely updates and presentations from a variety of speakers. They will also be given the opportunity to assemble into smaller groups for greater interaction and in-depth discussions during breakout sessions. In addition, attendees will convene with a State Regional Group or the Tribal Caucus for their individual spring meetings.

At the beginning of the new year, you will receive further correspondence regarding this event including a draft agenda, access to the registration site, group outing information, and much more—so please mark your calendar for the 2016 NTSF!

Who Should Attend?

NTSF meetings are designed for personnel associated with emergency management, security, inspection and enforcement, packaging and transportation, environmental protection, rules and regulations, and radiation protection in connection with shipments of radioactive waste and material.

The sessions at the 2016 Annual Meeting will be particularly relevant to personnel at the state, tribal, and federal level, as well as industry personnel that interact with government regulators.
